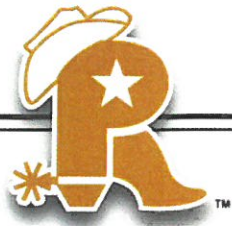
- ✓ Student will be a high school student for the 2018-2019 school year.
