As the clean up begins for many in the community, the Pasadena Livestock Show & Rodeo Executive Board extends continued thoughts and prayers for all those affected by Hurricane Harvey.

Just as many people and businesses in the community have been impacted; so, too, has the fairgrounds on which multiple facilities sit. Although the extent of damage and subsequent repairs for the Convention Center, Campbell Hall, Rodeo Arena, and Rodeo Office are still being assessed by the City, we have touched base with the tent companies, equipment companies, various vendors and sponsors, and we feel confident that we can proceed with our show with a few changes.

With any major entertainment event, there are many moving parts and great consideration has to be taken into account for our upcoming parade, cook-off, livestock show, and rodeo. Based on the communication efforts with all relevant parties, and very thorough discussion, the Executive Board has elected to make the following changes:

- The Badge Pick up on Sept. 7 has been cancelled. Directors will be responsible for collecting and distributing the badges for their respective committees after Sept. 7.
- The Parade will be rescheduled to Sept. 23
- The BBQ cook-off will be rescheduled to Oct. 27-29 (only available dates per the City of Pasadena)

The Rodeo, currently scheduled for Sept. 22 - Sept. 30, will go forward as planned, as will the Breakfast of Champions, Livestock Show, and Livestock Auction.

The sincere hope is that all PLSR volunteers are minimally impacted by these changes, and we can rally together to "Make Rodeo Great Again".
